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IMPORTANT ABOUT MOBILITY(1):

According to “*Rulebook on International Exchange of Students and Staff*” by University of Banja Luka – [LINK](#) (34 and 34.1):

- outgoing and incoming students must sign “Learning Agreement” **before mobility** (signed by student, responsible person at the sending and responsible person at the receiving institution);
- outgoing students from UBL **after mobility** must from receiving institution bring:
“Transcript of Records” - a document by which the higher education institution provides detailed data on the achieved academic results (grades, ECTS points) of the student, and/or
“Transcript of Work” - a document by which the receiving institution provides detailed information on the completed professional practice and achieved student results.

The same documents can incoming students receive from UBL!



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IMPORTANT ABOUT MOBILITY(2):

- Outgoing and incoming students who pursue exchange for the purpose of studying are obliged to accomplish activities expressed from at least three (3) ECTS points for each month spent in exchange during the period of realization of classes at the receiving institution (in this case, for mobility of 5 months students are obliged to accomplish 15 ECTS).
- The recognition of the exchange period is carried out by a *Commission for the recognition of the exchange period* on the basis of the similarities and learning outcomes of the courses, where the knowledge acquired by the student in exchange from a particular field does not have to be identical, but related to knowledge that would student acquire from a certain course at UBL.
