#### S – FORCE SYMPOSIUM - EYP WORKSHOP

#### **VENUE: Higher Technical School of Professional Studies premises** Address: Školska 1, Novi Sad

Second part of Symposium will be in line with the methodology of European Youth Parliament. All the students from WBC are appointed a working group – Committee. Each committee has its facilitator (from EYP Serbia) and journalist (provided by P1-P6) which organize and follow the work of each Committee. A Committee is given its own topic, which is in direct relation to the K-FORCE project theme. The workshop consists of three major parts, first of which is Teambuilding. Teambuilding represents a series of exercises aimed at establishing a positive working environment and good communication inside the Committees. The second part is Committee Work, during which the participants are tasked with creating a resolution to the topic at hand. This is done by analysing, discussing and formulating the problems and solutions to the topic, whilst consulting committee experts (P7-P11). At the end of Committee Work, these problems and solutions are drafted, in the form of resolutions submitted in the European Parliament. All of the resolution form the Resolution Booklet are are then individually debated on, attacked, defended and finally voted on by all the participants during the General Assembly, the third and final part of the working day. The aim of the General Assembly is to replicate the working procedures of the European Parliament.
