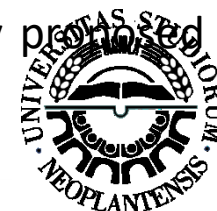
- Financial statement presenting the costs incurred during the reporting period

## **PARTNERS' TECHNICAL REPORTS**

The Technical report is structured as follows:

- Statistics and indicators - aims to gather statistical data and indicators of performance for the period covered by the reporting period;
- Table of achieved/planned results (one table per Work Package) with following describing elements:
  - Indicators of achievement and or/performance as indicated in the project proposal
  - Activities carried out to date to achieve the result
  - Activities to be carried out to achieve the outcome (before the end of the project)
  - Specific and measurable indicators of achievement/progress
  - Changes that have occurred in the result since the original proposal (any proposed changes: people involved, budget, remaining activities...).

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## **NARRATIVE REPORT**

# PROGRESS REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACTION (HALF-WAY THROUGH THE ELIGIBILITY PERIOD)

- Do not underestimate the amount of time necessary to write a report
- Do not copy and paste information from other reports (/the application)
- Answer the questions asked on the reporting template – no more no less
- Be honest : present problems (and the remedial actions launched) as well as achievements
- Perfect English required 😊

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# OFFICIAL FINANCIAL AUDIT

- Hiring of official auditor is in process at the University of Novi Sad.
- The auditor will be selected well in advance in order to control all the costs well in advance before the project end.
- The auditor will validate all the costs before the progress report for 1<sup>st</sup> part of the project.
- Every institution is obliged to nominate one person that will be in contact with the auditor and that will provide all required information and documents.
