In the morning KFORCE participants travel to Esbjerg (bus/train) individual arrangements. KFORCE visitors must arrive at Esbjerg campus by 13:00. We will begin with observing a 1st semester class in the program MTec Risk and Safety Management on Systems Engineering. The class is co-taught by Michael Faber (AAU), Linda Nielsen (AAU), Simona Miraglia (DTU), and Sebastian Glavind (DTU). On this date, we will have 4 student groups presenting their results from an exercise on system identification and system representation. The group work is carried out according to the Aalborg Problem Based Learning (PBL) method. After the student presentations, the director of the program Anders Kristensen Schmidt will talk about the program's history and vision for the future. KFORCE participants will have a chance to ask questions about the program's structure, content and didactic methodologies.
