LLL & PROFESSIONAL COURSES AT FSE UNIZA

FSE provides a number of courses outside the standard study programmes.

These courses are open for professionals as well as students (often at a discount rate).

There are three types of courses:

- 1. Courses which are required for obtaining a professional certificate or license for undertaking a specific work position, e.g. fire safety design specialist
- 2. Courses which are requierd for renewing a professional certificate or license, e.g. fire safety design specialists recertification every 5 years
- 3. Other courses aimed at specific topics such as crisis management in public administration, security management for private companies etc.







EXAMPLES OF COURSES OFFERED BY FSE UNIZA IN THE FIELD OF FIRE SAFETY ENGINEERING

Group 1 – obtaining a professional certificate or license

Basic preparation of fire safety design specialists (200 hours) and fire safety technicians (120 hours)

Group 2 – renewing a professional certificate or license

Actualisation preparation of fire safety design specialists (50 hours) and fire safety technicians (30 hours)

Group 3 – other courses

Introduction to fire safety for public authority employees (20 hours)

Group 1 & 2 usualy require accreditation or approval by the responible authority, e.g. Ministry of Interior





OTHER COURSES OFFERED BY FSE

- Effective crisis management,
- Security systems management in person and property protection,
- Information systems security for public organisations and private companies;
- Security manager for public organisations and private companies;
- Security staff course;
- Health & safety in workplace;
- Safety advisors for ADR, RID, ADN....







COOPERATION WITH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ORGANISATIONS

FSE has a strong cooperation with a number of public and private organisations in the following areas:

- Student internships and industry theses
- Courses and workshops for professionals
- Research and education projects cooperation
- Contractual and consulting work
- Standardisation

Areas to improve cooperation:

- Industry PhDs and MScs
- Life-long learning schemes multi-stakeholder and legal issues





EXAMPLE OF COOPERATION

Cooperation partners: Dept. of Fire Engineering, Fire and rescue service headquarters, private companies (funding)

Cooperation form: Series of building fire safety design workshops

Target audience: Fire safety inspectors (AHJ), Fire safety design specialists, Architects, Designers, usually around 60 attendees

Topics are selected to address actual problems in this field, e.g. multi-storey timber frame buildings, separation distances...


Particularly good for exchange of information and knowledge in "gray" areas.
