TRANSPORTATION TO BANJA LUKA AND IN THE CITY:

It is possible to arrive in Banja Luka by plane (direct lines from Stockholm and Belgrade). There is a bus from the airport to the city center, or taxi.

There are also airports in Tuzla, Belgrade, Zagreb, Ljubljana, Sarajevo, and then with a bus or a taxi to Banja Luka.

The most convenient way to move around the city, if you do not want to walk, is a taxi. The cost of taxi service within the city is from 1.5 to 6 euros.


